WHAT SHOULD WE SAY ABOUT PLANNED PARENTHOOD?

Videos from The Center for Medical Progress point out what we’ve known all along: Planned Parenthood is an organization dedicated to destroying life, and has little interest even in those it purports to serve.

With video evidence of its executives showing a willingness to manipulate abortions in order to capture and sell the body parts of children, Planned Parenthood is in trouble. Its attempt to defend these practices is feeble at best, abhorrent to mainstream Americans at worst.

A congressional investigation is coming, numerous lawmakers are thinking of ways to defund the abortion giant, and businesses once seen as supporting Planned Parenthood are backing off in droves.

But what are we to do with this information? Post it on Facebook? Tweet it? While the dissemination of the facts is important, it is vital that we have a plan of action.

First, we can encourage our representatives to investigate these issues fully, and suspend any funding for Planned Parenthood during this time. Hopefully, we can defund Planned Parenthood totally. But a suspension of funding while the investigations continue is a start.

Second, we can look at businesses that support the abortion goliath and let them know we too are customers of theirs—and do not want our support for these businesses ending up in the hands of Planned Parenthood.

Third, I ask all of us to remember those organizations which compete directly with Planned Parenthood. The reason so many go to Planned Parenthood is that though it is the nation’s number one abortion provider, they position themselves as a place of choice with no judgment. Therefore, clients come—but are sold only one product: Abortion.

Pregnancy Resources of Doraville is a home for true choice. We offer information on all options and provide assistance and support for all life-affirming choices, whether single-parenting, co-parenting, marriage or adoption. And for those who have suffered an abortion, we offer healing.

A young woman without an appointment came in the door seeking a pregnancy test and conversation about her question, "What am I going to do now that the test is positive?" The mentor who worked with her gave her answers, suggestions, and solutions to the problems and issues she presented. But there was still unrest in the demeanor of this young woman.

Then the question came up as to her relationship with Jesus. Her reply was heartbreaking. As a child she had attended a church with her grandmother, but never had anyone talked with her about what worship was or who the object of worship should be. She just went because her grandmother made her go. Additionally, she had experienced abuse—verbal, physical, and sexual — about which none of family knew anything
