## THROUGH OUR DOORS

There are many things for which we at PROD need to praise our Heavenly Father. Through our doors have come many opportunities to represent His love to clients.

- For instance, there are **62 babies are living today** that otherwise would have been aborted were it not for the intervention of staff and volunteers. **Abstinence was boldly taught** to single women and their partners. The difference of that knowledge in relationships now and in the future can only be assumed.
- Most importantly, **14 people changed their eternal direction** by making a decision to follow Christ.
- We have served **women from 36 countries**, helping us to answer the call of taking Christ to all nations without ever leaving Atlanta. Like a stone upon a lake, the ripples of our intervention can reach nations through families.
- Our location across from a MARTA train station makes us **conveniently accessible** to a wide range of women who might not otherwise have transportation. Since we are located within 5 miles of four of Georgia's most active abortion mills, we are increasingly sensitive to the **urgency of our mission** of promoting life and hope.
- And last but certainly not least, our accountant tells us that **80% of all funds we receive go directly to client support**.

## VOLUNTEER VIEWPOINT

I have recently completed the training program offered at PROD to serve as a volunteer, and what an awesome four days of learning it was! Kudos to our trainers for presenting the material thoroughly, creating interest as they covered a number of topics. The training builds on biblical foundations, client care, communication skills, abortion education and positive options to abortion.

During training, a volunteer learns that our top goals are to: **1.** Meet our clients & let them know they have walked into a place of love, care and respect. The intention is to take down the client's anxiety level and build up comfort and trust. **2.** Spend time practicing communication skills to help our client through feelings and emotions and to define the facts of her situation. **3.** To learn that as a client mentor I must tell the truth in love, share that God values life, and then openly discuss options.

I was **WOWED** by the center's resource room. I received an introduction to the information available to help our clients make educated decisions. It will take some time to get familiar with all the vast resources.

As Christians, and with our training, we always try to share some life principles that will equip our clients with "life giving" decisions yielding new outcomes in the future.
